- 2. Drop your raffle ticket in the RED box



WWISCAA's Drive-Thru Food Festival

Your ticket entitles you to 2 plates from the booths of your choice. You can not select which food items you want from the booth; the group will serve what they have prepared.

- 1. For safety purposes, please wear a mask.
- Pull up; show your ticket; receive a wristband, raffle ticket & souvenir bag. Fill out the raffle ticket & sign form to acknowledge receipt of items. If you do not have a ticket, you may purchase one @ the GREEN BOOTH for \$15.00. We will not be able to change large bills over \$20
- 3. Review the menu on the opposite side & decide which booths you want to get your plates from.
- 4. Each booth is color-coded on the menu and on the diagram




- 5. Drive thru to the first booth you have selected (1-6).
- STAY IN YOUR VEHICLE. Roll down your window. Give the staff your ticket to punch. This will indicate you have received a plate from them.
- 7. Proceed to the next chosen booth and repeat the process.
- 8. Pay close attention that you do not pass the booth(s) you have decided upon, because you will not be able to turn around.
- 9. If you pass the booth you intended to stop at, select another one or exit and get at the end of the drive-thru line.
- Once your ticket has been punched 2 times, you can not receive another plate using that ticket.
- After receiving your plates, stop at the BLACK BOOTH-(COLD DRINKS) to pick up your beverage.
- 12. Drop the raffle ticket in the **RED Box** @ the **BLACK BOOTH**. If you are a winner, you will be notified when & where to pick up your gift.
- 13. **EXIT** or Park and Eat in the Designated area.
